



1. JASON DIAZ Kellenberg, P/OF

One of the top RHP Prospects in the Nation. Velocity is 88-92 mph and has touched 93 with serious sink. Excellent mound presence. His slider is developing into another plus pitch. **Committed to University of Miami.**

2. ROMAN DOROSH Sachem East, RHP/OF

Has the ability to be a very good 2-way option. On the mound he throws his FB upper 80's and touches 90 mph. His slider is already a plus pitch. The best competitor in the class on the mound. Offensively he hits with line drive capabilities to all fields.



3. TIM McHUGH Commack, OF

Advanced athleticism makes him one of the top outfield prospects in the country. Offensively he has the power and the consistency in his swing to handle top flight pitching. Projects as a draft prospect for 2019. **Committed to TCU.**



4. DAVE FALCO Center Moriches, RHP/CINF

2019 draft prospect. His velocity is 88-90 and has touched 93 mph. sharp late BB. Great size and athleticism. Gap to gap line drive abilities. Runs well. Good hands defensively. **Committed to University of Maryland.**

5. JOE SAVINO Connetquot, RHP

Power arm frame with ¾ arm slot. Whippy arm action with good run and sink. Has plus movement. Upper 80's FB. Sharp slider that he commands well. High ceiling prospect.



6. MAX NEILSEN Ward Melville, LHP

Features a mid-80's FB with run & sink. His BB is sharp with good command. High end competitor. One of the top LHP prospects in the northeast. Contributes on the offensive end. **Committed to UCONN.**



7. WILLIAM KENNEDY Smithtown East, LHP/1B

Legit 2-way player. Sweet athletic swing. Good actions around the bag w soft hands. Mid 80's FB with good command. Outstanding Change. Throws strikes with all pitches. Winning player. **Committed to Hofstra.**

8. JAKE KRZEMIENSKI Commack, LHP/1B/OF

Versatile player. On the mound he has a good feel and presence with a low 80's FB and plus secondary pitches. Offensively he has a compact swing which translates into high contact rate. Soft hands and good instincts defensively. Excellent all-around player.



9. JARED YALON Connetquot, 1B/OF

High end offensive player. Jared has a compact LH swing that produces a lot of bat speed and lift. Has a high probability to develop +power. A good athlete who can play multiple positions including pitch. **Committed to Stony Brook University.**



10. MIKE FLORIDES St. Dominics, SS

Athletic player with smooth actions and +arm. Projects to be a plus defender at the college level. Wiry body type that allows for a loose & fluid swing. **Committed to Boston College.**



11. LUKE NAPOLITANO Kellenberg, MINF

Solid offensive player that has top of order ability at the next level. Defensive skills set that projects him on the left side. High baseball IQ. **Committed to University of Pitt.**

12. AIDAN LARKIN Chaminade, MINF

Sure handed fielder with good feet and instincts. Polished offensive approach with line drive abilities. Well-rounded player. Excellent feel for the game.



13. JAKE LAZZARO Oceanside, MINF

Top of the order hitter. Plus speed who has gap power. Has excellent range as a defender. Quick feet and actions. Plays fast. **Committed to St. Johns University.**

14. PAUL ORBON Chaminade, OF

Athletic Build. Gap to gap hitter with good power. Could be one of the better true hitters in the class. Is a plus a runner. High ceiling player.

15. DOUG GOODWIN Smithtown East, RHP

High end pitch ability and competitor. Commands 3 pitches for strikes. FB is low to mid-80's. Everything is down in the zone. Very consistent. Varsity starter on a good team as a freshman. Winner.

16. STEVEN RIZZO St. Anthonys, MINF

Swing is loose and athletic which leads to a lot of contact. Has potential to be a middle of order hitter at next level. Has above average arm strength. Can play all 3 OF spots. Solid all around athlete.



17. DEREK YALON

Connetquot, OF

Strong offensive player with good bat speed. Has a power presence. Can play either corner OF spot in an above average manner. **Committed to Stony Brook University.**

18. TOMMY REIFLER

Garden City, MINF

Smart headsy players with plus hands defensively and good instincts. Top of order contact hitter who uses all fields. Has excellent bat control.

19. MATT YIP

Herricks, C

Solid offensive player w power. Hard contact with good lift. Defensively has a great frame for a catcher with a 2- 2.10 POP time. Has a good upside behind plate. Runs well and is an excellent athlete for the position.

20. LOGAN KOESTER

Chaminade, RHP/3B

Has a big upside. Logan has a mid to upper 80's FB that has a lot of arm side run. Arm angle is tough on RH hitters. Sweeping type BB. Has power at the plate.

21. ROBERT MILOPSKY

Rocky Pt INF/P

Strong/sturdy RHP. Pitches to both sides of the plate well. FB in the mid to upper 80's. Attaches hitter with FB. Breaking ball is sharp and he commands it well.

22. CHARLIE CUCCHIARA

East Meadow, RHP/INF

Low to mid 80's RHP with excellent movement and command. CB is his out pitch with a developing Change up. Tough competitor and cerebral pitcher. Challenges hitters.

23. MATT LEWIN

North Shore, OF

A Burner with CF defensive abilities at the next level. Compact line drive approach. Prototypical lead-off hitter.

24. CHRIS PALMER

East Islip, RHP

6'5" power arm. Low to mid-80's with a power CB. Good command with a high ceiling. Cerebral pitcher with a good feel for pitches and strong mound presence.



25. NICK SCHWARTZ

Massapequa, C

Quick/athletic actions behind the plate. Good hands. Accurate throwing arm. 2.0-2.1 pop times. Offensively he runs well. Makes good contact and has surprising power. **Committed to St. Johns University.**

26. MATT DIGENNARO

Ward Melville, RHP

¾ arm slow with a mid-80's FB. Slider is sharp. Has good command and throws strikes. Competitive instincts. Very repeatable delivery.



27. BEN KOVEL

Calhoun, P

Has excellent arm strength. Throws downhill with mid to upper 80's FB. Ball has late life. Breaking ball has late break. **Committed to Fordham.**

28. JAKE EDWARDS

Calhoun, 3B/OF

Has gap to gap power with an advanced approach. Tough to strike out. An athletic defender who can play both corner OF and INF spots.

29. CAMERON MAYER

Syosset, RHP

Tall/projectable frame. Has a live arm. FB is mid to upper 80's and has late life. Breaking ball has good downward tilt. Up and coming prospect.



30. AIDAN TORNQUIST

HHH West, LHP

Tough/aggressive LHP. Mid 80's FB that is deceptive to hitters and gets on top of hitters quickly. Off-speed pitches are improving. Bulldog mentality. **Committed to Fordham.**

31. MICHAEL STORMS

Smithtown East, LHP/1B

Power frame with a high ceiling. Low to mid-80's FB that projects to be upper 80's. 12 to 6 BB. Developing command. Bright future. Will contribute offensively.

32. JAKE PIERRE

Sachem North, MINF

Left handed hitting 2-hole type hitter. High contact and OBP. Good bat control. Sure handed defensively w above average range. Has a high baseball IQ.

33. COLIN DIEZ

Division, OF

Can play all 3 Outfield positions. Aggressive top of the order hitter who makes consistent hard contact. Athletic actions in the OF with solid arm strength.

34. JUSTIN VENTURA

Lindenhurst, OF

Fast twitch actions offensively. Strong swing w intent. Has power. Speedy OF who can run. Has really high upside.

35. CHRIS DESOUSA

Massapequa, OF/P

Strong & athletic build. Aggressive approach offensively with + bat speed. Has the ability to play all 3 OF spots. Mid 80's FB on the mound with above ave breaking ball. Hard worker.

36. ANDREW VEIT

Bellport, OF/P

Superb athlete that covers a lot of ground defensively. Developing as an offensive player w speed who projects as top of the order hitter. Will contribute on mound as well.

37. BRYCE GRATWOHL

Mattituck, RHP/3B

Athletic pitchers frame. Loose arm swing. 3-pitch mix with a low to mid-80's FB. Offensively he has raw power with solid bat speed. Will draw 2 way interest on the college level.

38. NICK LOMONACO

William Floyd, OF

Athletic build with +arm. Runs well and has ability to be a CF on the next level. Top of the order type hitter with a compact swing.

39. SEAN MENDYK

Plainedge, LHP

Tall frame with a very projectable body. Loose/elastic arm action. Throws downhill. FB has reached the mid-80's. Generates a lot of swings and misses. Breaking ball is improving and becoming a viable second pitch.

40. CHANDLER GIOVINCO

Newfield, P/INF

Loose arm action. FB velocity is mid 80's and due to his live arm it projects to increase quickly. Off-speed pitches are above avg. Very interesting prospect with high upside.

41. PHIL KRPATA

Farmingdale, OF

High energy level. Plus defender with above avg arm & speed. Aggressive approach offensively. Top of the order hitter. Intense player.

42. ANDREW BIANCO

Kings Park, 1B/OF/P

Excellent frame and athlete. Versatile defender. Projectable abilities. Short and compact swing. Middle of the lineup type player. Varsity starter as freshman. High ceiling player.

43. MICHAEL LADONNA

West Islip, P/OF

Excellent pitching prospect. Low to mid 80's FB. Challenges hitters. Very aggressive in his approach. Solid athlete in the outfield.

44. JUSTIN HARVEY

Smithtown East, C/OF

Athletic player who is very versatile. Can play any position on the field. Solid defensively behind the plate with accurate arm. Moves well behind the plate. Can be a top of the order hitter with above avg speed.
