CASTAGNOZZI**
Massapequa, INF

One of the top infield prospects on the East Coast. Exceptional athleticism, pro-frame and arm strength. Offensively he shows a mature approach with explosive bat speed. True power potential. **Committed to the University of North Carolina.**



1 (TIE). BROCK MURTHA
Sayville, INF/RHP

One of the top 2-way prospects on the East Coast. Defensively his athleticism & speed will allow him to play multiple positions on the field. Offensively he has a quick twitch swing that leads to +power. On the mound his fastball sits in the 86-88 mph range with late life. He has a power breaking ball. **Committed to the University of Notre Dame.**

3. KEVIN BOWROSEN

Miller Place, INF/OF/RHP

Has a polished and classic LH swing that produces gap to gap consistency. Can really hit! Defensively his athleticism allows him to play the left side of the INF and OF. He can help on the mound with a low to mid 80's fastball.



4. CARLOS HIDALGO
St. Dominic's, OF/RHP

Very athletic frame with a high skill set. Garnering Div I interested as a 2-way player. Offensively he shows the ability to have true gap to gap power. Defensively he has the ability to stay in CF. Has a mid-80's fastball with a sharp breaking ball. **Committed to St. Johns University.**



5. DON WILLE
Sachem East, C/1B

Pro-frame with exceptional skill sets. Pop time is in the 1.95-2.10 range. He is a physical presence at the plate with true power to all fields. Middle of the lineup bat at the next level. **Committed to Fordham.**



6. MATT PELCHER
Calhoun, C

A true shut down catcher defensively. His pop times are in the 1.95-2.10 range with accuracy. Offensively has line drive capabilities to all fields. **Committed to Hofstra.**

7. ALEX UNGAR

Connetquot, INF/RHP

Athletic/wirey frame with room for more. Plus defensive skill sets give him the ability to play any infield position. Offensively he has a loose/athletic swing that allows for use of the whole field. He features a low to mid 80's FB on the mound with potential for more.



8. RYAN LEVENBERG
Hauppauge, LHP

Loose and athletic arm swing with a projectable frame. Has a 3-pitch mix featuring a low to mid 80's FB. Has good command of his secondary. **Committed to Hofstra.**

9. JACK REARDON

St. Anthony's, MINF

Defensively has a sticky glove with polished actions. Good instincts! Top of the order offensive skill set with good barrel control. Very steady player.



10. TRAVIS HONEYMAN
Massapequa, MINF/OF

Athletic players with quick twitch actions. Plays bigger than his body type. Defensively he features a strong accurate arm with quick actions. Offensively he shows good power potential for his frame with a aggressive approach. **Committed to Boston College.**



11. JOE WOZNY
The Stony Brook School, RHP

Power frame with projectable body type. Features a high 80's FB with the ability for more. Developing secondary pitches makes him a very interesting prospect. **Committed to UCONN**

12. JUSTIN ROSNER

Farmingdale, RHP

Excellent control and command of 3 pitches. Features a mid-80's FB with advanced feel. Likes the ball in his hands and has had success in big games.

13. MATT BROWN-EIRING

Connetquot, INF/RHP

Versatile player. Sure-handed infield defender with an accurate strong arm. Offensively has the ability to consistently find the barrel against good pitching. On the mound he features a low to mid 80's FB and secondary pitches that he commands for strikes.

14. CHRIS GIARDINO

Clarke, C

High energy catcher with solid skills behind the plate. Pop times are in the 2.10-2.15 range. Offensively he has a solid/compact swing that leads to line drives to all fields.

15. XAVIER CRUZ

Kellenberg, OF

Athletic frame. Middle of the order bat with a compact swing that should transition well to the college level. Defensively he possesses a solid/strong & accurate arm.

16. ROB MANETTA

Farmingdale, C

Wirey/Athletic frame with more to add. Defensively he has a pop time in the 2.05-2.15 range. Has solid over all defensive skill set. Offensively he is a switch-hitting catcher- which is rare. He has shown the ability to do so. Both swings are loose and athletic. Interesting prospect

17. NICK PAPAGEORGE

Wheatley, 1B/P

Solid 2-way prospect with a high ceiling. Frame projects. Offensively he is a middle of the order hitter with gap to gap power. He is a solid defender around the bag. He features a mid-80's fastball with a great feel for change up and breaking ball.

18. JORDAN DELUCIA

Kellenberg, OF/P

Mature/athletic frame. Top of the order hitter with a quick/strong swing. Speed & arm strength make him a true CF prospect. On the mound he features a low 80's FB with developing off speed.

19. MIKE PRISCO

Newfield, C/OF

Strong frame with projectability and athletic skills. Offensively he is one of the top LH hitters in the class with an advanced approach at the plate and the ability to hit better pitching. Defensively he has a 2.1-2.15 pop time and enough speed and quickness to cover ground in the OF.

20. JACK GRECO

Harborfields, OF/RHP

Top of the lineup hitter with good barrel awareness. Defensively he has good first step instincts and quick hands. His fastball is low 80's with a + change up.

21. JAMES MYLER

Longwood, OF/1B/P

A hitters frame with an advanced feel to hit. Ready to hit at all times. An above avg runner gives him the ability to play OF. He is low to mid 80's on the mound.

22. IDRIS CARTER

Roosevelt, INF/OF

Athlete with the ability to play most positions. Wirey frame with room to grow. Extremely high ceiling. Can hit one through five in the lineup. Contributes on the mound.

23. JUSTICE SPENCER

Ward Melville, OF

Excellent body type-very projectable. Football QB. Offensively he has excellent skill set which leads to a scholarship. Good speed which gives him the ability to play CF at the next level. Offensively his swing allows for gap to gap line drive capabilities.

24. CHRIS CUMBO

Clarke, MINF

Plays with great energy. Outstanding barrel awareness makes him a top of the order threat. Rangy defender with a sticky glove. Fun to watch play.

25. TOMMY VERGA

William Floyd, INF/RHP

Solid middle of the order bat with compact swing. Power potential. Left-side of the infield type defender. Features a low 80's fastball on the mound.

26. MATT POLESTINO

John Glenn, OF/LHP

Hard working two-way player. Line drive capabilities with good speed and ability to play CF. Quick arm. On the mound he pitches in the low-80's and his arm can touch better.

27. BOBBY DICAPUA

West Islip, RHP

Made a huge jump this year. Has strong upside. Fastball is low to mid 80's and gets on hitters quickly. Throws strikes. Off speed pitch is becoming above avg. Good upside

28. FRANCESCO GERACI

Bayport Blue Point, 2B

Solid 2-way player on both ends. Strong/compact swing that generates power. High contact ratio. Very solid hands defensively. Feet work well. Smooth around the bag turning two. Runs well. Good college prospect.

29. MICHAEL CIMINIELLO

Smithtown East 1B/LHP

Frame is maturing and looks to be able to fill in nicely. Offensively he has a compact swing with good barrel awareness. Defensively he is solid around the bag with good instincts. On the mound he has a low 80's fastball with good command of secondary pitches.

30. TYLER GALLETTI

St. Anthony's, C

Traditional catchers build with a polished defensive skill set. Pop times range from 2.08-2.15 with accuracy. Offensively he shows good gap to gap capabilities.

31. WILL MCCARTHY

Holy Trinity, RHP

Excellent pitchers frame at 6'3". Has shown the ability to compete well as a sophomore in the Catholic league. Fastball is low to mid 80's. Curveball and change-up are well polished for age.

32. SEAN KENNEDY

East Meadow, OF/RHP

Strong build. Solid and accurate arm as a corner OF with good speed. Has a low 80's fastball on the mound with a deceptive delivery.

33. ALEX RENDE

Massapequa, MINF

High energy player with great instincts. Handles the bat well from the left side with his speed playing well into his game.

34. GIANCARLO GIACOMETTI

St. John the Baptist, RHP

Strike thrower who likes to challenge hitters and get ahead. Throws 3 pitches with good command. Contributes offensively.

35. FRANK WHITENACK

Plainedge, 3B/RHP

Excellent athletic frame with potential to grow. Steady defender with a plus arm. Offensively he has a lot of hard contact. Features a low to mid 80's fastball with good arm side run. Good use of his secondary pitches in game.

36. MATT MILONE

SJB, OF

Athletic player who can play any OF position. Above avg. arm. Provides quality AB's with high contact rate. Should develop above avg. power. Projectable prospect

37. ALEX ERICKSON

Chaminade, RHP

Fastball is in the low 80's. Has a lanky/loose arm action with room for more. Best pitch is his curveball.

38. ADAM BURK

Eastport-South Manor, RHP/1B

Big/athletic athlete. Above avg arm strength with low 80's fastball. Has a good upside due to his athleticism. His pitches are "heavy" and tough to elevate. Shows power on offensive end especially to the pull side

39. CAMERON LEARY

St. Anthony's, OF

Smooth LH swing with above avg. pop. Uses all fields well. Has above avg. arm. +speed as well.

40. SEAN DELAHUNTY

Holy Trinity, C

Varsity starter since a freshman. Developing receiving and blocking skills. Pop times range from 2.1-2.25. Middle of the order type bat with ability to use all fields.

41. ROB COPOZZI

Center Moriches, RHP/1B

His 6'4" frame is ideal for mound. Has a low to mid 80's fastball. Good depth to curveball. Could project higher as he continues to develop.

42. KYLE TORCIVIA

Walt Whitman, RHP

Tall/rangy RHP improving leaps & bounds. Throws downhill. Ball gets on top of hitters quickly. Breaking ball is becoming above avg. Strong upside as a prospect.

43. KRISTIAN RAFSOL

Kellenberg, INF

Stout build. Very solid offensive player with high contact rate. Can go line to line with some pop.

44. JIMMY MAHONEY

MacArthur, INF

Sure handed defender with versatility to play multiple INF positions. Has a consistent/compact approach which leads to line drives. Contributes on the mound.

45. CHRIS PUPA

Seaford, LHP

Very good/deceptive delivery. Hard to pick ball out of hand. Low 80's FB with a true 12/6 curveball. Good feel for strikezone.

46. ANDREW LEDBETTER

Walt Whitman, C/OF

Best throwing positional arm in the class. Pop times in the 1.95-2.05 range. Wiry/athletic frame. Improved defensive skill set. Line drive capabilities with above avg speed on the offensive side.

47. JOE PELLEGRINO

Commack, 2B

Top of the order hitter who has excellent bat control. High contact hitter with good discipline. Solid on the defensive end. Turns 2 well.

48. DYLAN BRUNO

St. Dominic's, P/OF

Developing nicely over the past year. Has the ability to play all OF spots. Top of the order type bat with high contact rate. Low 80's velocity on the mound. Clean mechanics with an above avg change up.

49. KENNY FRANQUIZ

Mephram, INF

Versatile infielder with quick actions and above avg range. Profiles as a top of the order hitter. Excellent base runner which puts pressure on the defense.

50. PAUL GOMES

Mt. Sinai, OF

Top of the order hitter with a compact swing who uses all fields well. Has an advanced approach. Good first step reads in outfield.

51. NICK RUSSO

St. John the Baptist, INF

Slick fielding MINF with accurate throwing arm. High contact rate and shows ability to use all fields. On base a lot.

52. JARED SCIARRINO

Longwood, INF/OF

Top of order LH. Consistent contact. Above avg runner. On defensive side he can play multiple positions in INF & OF.

53. RYAN MICHELLI

Sachem East, C

Hard-nosed player with good leadership qualities. Plays the game the right way. Accurate throwing arm with pop time 2.10-2.20. Compact swing with quick hands.

54. MARCO ALI

St. Anthonys, INF

Athletic approach to game. Excellent in game hitter. Arm should keep him on the left side of INF as he continues to develop.

55. LOGAN DRUCKER

Smithtown East, C/3B

Solid athlete with strong skill set. Good feet behind the plate with an above avg arm. power at times.

56. DEREK LIVINGSTON

Port Washington, RHP

High end pitch ability. Competes with a 3-pitch mix. FB in low 80's. Has a knack for pitching out of tough situations. Winner!

57. PHIL MENIST

Great Neck South, LHP

Velocity gets into the low 80's. Excellent feel and command for his age. Has 4 quality pitches. Velocity will increase as he gains strength.

58. DANTE DIMARCO

Calhoun, C/3B

Strong arm with quick release. Good carry. Ball jumps off bat with gap power. Can run very well. Above avg baseball IQ.

59. RYAN HYNES

Ward Melville, P/1B

Athletic frame with a good upside on the mound. Velocity has room to grow. Has a good feel for throwing strikes. Contributes on the offensive end as well. Good defender.

60. NOAH FRASCA

SJB, C/INF

Versatile and intelligent player. Understands the game well. Has above avg arm. Excellent receiving skills with good hands. Offensively he is a high contact player who is productive.
